CATASTROPHIC EVENT CRITICAL PATH

- Scene call from insured driver, plant manager, safety manager or law enforcement to terminal or claims center
- Call to assigned program manager
- Call to the Zarwin Baum CAT Response Team for risk assessment and team deployment
- Scene deployment by counsel, field adjusters and accident reconstruction team for “Hot Loss”
- Immediate phone contact with driver, plant or safety manager

CATASTROPHIC EVENT CRITICAL PATH

- Field compliance with all applicable FMSCR, OSHA and DOT regulations
- Deployment of accident reconstruction team for evidence collection and preservation
- Field interviews of all witnesses, law enforcement and emergency responders
- Assistance in clean up, storage and preservation of evidence to prevent spoilation
- Secure driver, plant or safety manager for post-accident interview



TIMELY CATASTROPHIC REPORTING

- Scene updates on physical injuries, property damage and environmental hazards
- Privileged counsel interviews with driver plant or safety manager
- Early log book, EBOR, DOT and OSHA compliance evaluation
- CAT conference coordination with all claims professionals, investigators, field experts and counsel
- Evolving CAT conference memorandums setting forth damage and liability analysis for claims team
