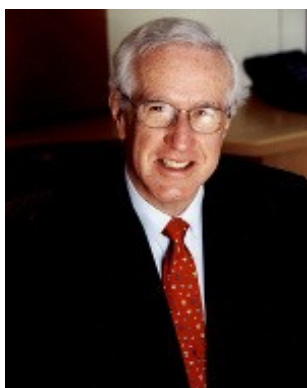

Two Philadelphians Honored for Helping to Help Save Lives in Israel

PHILADELPHIA, April 27—The Philadelphia Friends of American Friends of Magen David Adom (AFMDA) have honored **Norman P. Zarwin** and **E.
