- Scene call from insured driver or law enforcement to terminal or claims center
- Call to assigned program manager
- Call to the Zarwin Baum CAT Response Team for risk assessment and team deployment
- Scene deployment by counsel, field adjusters and accident reconstruction team for “Hot Loss”
- Immediate phone contact with driver

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE CATASTROPHIC EVENT CRITICAL PATH

- Field compliance with all applicable FMSCR and DOT regulations
- Deployment of accident reconstruction team for evidence collection and preservation
- Field interviews of all witnesses, law enforcement and emergency responders
- Assistance in clean up and storage of power unit and chassis
- Secure driver for post-accident interview
